DIRECTIONS

Staplefield is about 5 miles S of Crawley on the E side of the A23. Take the M23 from the North or A23 from the South. About 1 mile S of Handcross village, or 1 mile N of Bolney, turn off and head E on a minor road signposted to Staplefield. At the cross-roads on the village green, turn right. The hall is about 200m S of the green on the right. (See over for maps)

There is a reasonably sized car park by the hall and cars can be parked on the road if necessary.
