DIRECTIONS

Staplefield is 5 miles S of Crawley on the B2114 - East of the A23.

FROM THE NORTH: Leave the M23 at Junction 11 for Pease Pottage Services and continue on the B2114 through Handcross to Staplefield. The hall is on the right shortly after (south of) the X-roads on the village green.

FROM THE SOUTH: Leave the A23 on the B2115 (signed to Cuckfield, etc) - back over the A23. At Slough Green (about 1.5miles), turn left onto the B2114 and continue to Staplefield. The hall is on your left just before you reach the village green.

There is a reasonably sized car park by the hall and cars can be parked on the road if necessary.

MUSIC: The Sacred Harp, 1991 Edn (loan copies available) and an alternative singing booklet.
